As a reminder to anyone holding an AEE certification:

Each certified professional is required to obtain Continuing Education Units (CEU) or Professional Development Hours (PDH) each renewal period. AEE does not maintain a record of your continuing education in the interim so you must maintain your own record of continuing education and complete a recertification form at the time of your renewal. A total of 10 renewal credits are required utilizing a combination of the following:

- Employment in energy activities
- Membership in a professional organization
- Office held in professional organization
- Continuing education (courses, seminars)
- Energy conference attendance
- Professional awards or published/presented papers

Submittal Deadline: April 3, 2015

Scholarship Amounts: \$500, \$1,000, and \$2,000

The Foundation of the Association of Energy Engineers (FAEE) Scholarship Fund was established to promote continuing education of qualified professionals in energy engineering and energy management.

FAEE was established in 1981 to encourage qualified practitioners in energy engineering to further education. To date, the Foundation has helped more than 1,200 energy engineering students in the US.

Eligible Studies: Scholarships are available to candidates obtaining their undergraduate or graduate degrees who are enrolled in an accredited Colorado college or university focusing on energy engineering or energy management. Colorado residency is not required although applicants must be at sophomore standing or above for the 2014-2015 academic year.
